1. (76-16950-1) 43-year-old female with breast mass (contributed by Dr. D.W. Buntine).
2. (75-13151) 75-year-old male with recurrent nasal polyp (contributed by Dr. H. Benediktsson).
3. (76-360) A female infant, delivered by Caesarean Section and dying 45 minutes after birth. No relevant maternal history (contributed by Dr. Robert G. Stark).
4. (6340) 30-year-old female with a neck lump (contributed by Dr. B. Johnston).
5. (WA-2295-76A; WA-2295-76E) Tissues are from a flock of captive wild waterfowl (both ducks and geese). The flock history is of sudden death, sometimes associated with dysentery (contributed by Dr. Frank A. Juck, Vet. Path.).
6. (C-7943-76) Tissue submitted is from a rapidly growing mammary tumor, from a 7-year-old poodle. The animal had ovario hysterectomy done June 30/76 (contributed by Dr. Frank A. Juck, Vet. Path.).
7. (C-7939-76) A 7-year-old SF Cocker Spaniel was presented to a vet. with difficulty in swallowing and pain on palpation of the neck. Examination revealed a large pedunculated tonsil on the right side (contributed by Dr. Frank A. Juck, Vet. Path.).
8. (B-2609-76) The tissue of interest (lung) is from a near term bovine neonate that lived one day and died in respiratory difficulty (Contributed by Dr. Frank A. Juck, Vet. Path.).

C7939-76. 7 year old SF cocker spaniel Poorly differentiated was presented to a vet with difficulty swallowing and pain on palpation of neck.
