DIAGNOSIS: Embryonal mesonephroma.

2. C 0054-77 Slowly enlarging forearm mass in a 9 year old spayed F crossbred dog.

DIAGNOSIS: Hemangiopericytoma.

1. WGH 76-15722 26 M with a congenital hemangioma-like lesion of buttock.

DIAGNOSIS: Cellular blue nevus.

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2. WGH 76-17795 7<sup>0</sup> M with a sebaceous cyst-like lesion of ear pinna for 3 weeks.

DIAGNOSIS: Relapsing polychondritis.

- ⑦ DR. D. MORROW 126-72 Gum lesion in 60 M  
DIAGNOSIS: Recurrent ameloblastoma with pseudoepitheliomatous hyperplasia.
- ⑧ DR. W.S. HWANG 21801-76 30 F, P 2 G 2, on ORACON combination oral contraceptive therapy for several years followed by 2 normal menses and subsequent amenorrhea. ? Pregnancy.  
DIAGNOSIS: Atypical drug-associated adenomatous endometrial hyperplasia with squamous metaplasia.
- ⑨ DR. H. BENEDIKTSSON 22295-76 65 M with recent onset of malaise.  
DIAGNOSIS: Borderline lymphocytic lymphoma (Followup report to come)
- ⑩ DR. D.W. BUNTINE 20399-76 59 M with thyroid enlargement.  
DIAGNOSIS: Squamous cell carcinoma of thyroid.
- ⑪ DR. D. OWEN M156-73 35 Malawi M. with foot nodules for 2 years.  
DIAGNOSIS: Kaposi sarcoma.
- ⑫ DR. R. G. STARK 1. 76-549 60 M with dyspnea, cough and blood tinged sputum for 3 weeks prior to admission.  
DIAGNOSIS: Collision oat cell and squamous cell bronchoalveolar carcinoma.

DIAGNOSIS: Apocrine mixed tumour of skin.
- ⑬ DR. B. JOHNSTON A-4564-76 91 M with Duke' C adenocarcinoma of rectum who succumbed to the sequelae of atherosclerotic coronary artery disease. Tissue submitted from diaphragmatic nodule and para-aortic lymph node.  
DIAGNOSIS: Poorly differentiated extramedullary plasmacytoma with hyperlobulinemia.
